Tips for the school year

Information and communication

- -Visit our GoogleClassroom (make sure you join the correct period) and your GoogleClassroom and our class website early and often https://cloviseastwhittakerhonorsbiology.weebly.com/. Features include our weekly assignments f, access to digital copy of our textbook, our class syllabus/policies, grade breakdown, ALL Semester 1 vocabulary lists, and extremely helpful tutorial links for all of the curriculum we will be covering this school year.
- -Most weeks we will have a class meeting at the start of the week to review our class agenda via Zoom. Each week our assignments, directions form completion/grading, point totals and due date/times will always be listed. Basically, there are no surprises in our class. Students will always know how to earn full credit on assignments and will always know due dates and assessment dates.
- -As my attention is providing students with the best instruction each day, email is the best way to communicate with me for both students and parents in lieu of phone calls during instruction time. Please provide me with at least 1 school day to reply during school hours. Most of our school to home communication regarding our class, our assignments, and your student will be completed via email and Remind.
- -Students will be informed regarding our class cell phone policy, and student integrity during assessments and class time. Depending on the format of the school day, students may be asked to check their phones into our "Cell Hotel" on a regular basis to support instruction, follow assessment security expectations, and to support communication and academic discourse/critical thinking exercises

Perseverance, Grades and Support

- -Grades will be updated on a regular basis and can be reviewed using CUSD Student or Parent Connect. Be sure you get your username and password from the CEHS main office.
- -Worried about Science Fair, Science Olympiad, Robotics, or the Research Paper? <u>Don't be</u>. This year, students will be assigned the default research paper as their Honors Biology requirement. Depending on the format of the school year, and co-curricular offerings, students may be able to complete an alternative assignment by participating in one of the above teams/projects. We will deal with this as information becomes available and I will never delay in keeping you updated. I've got you covered! We will spend lots of time making sure you know which option fits you best, how to get help, and who to go to for support.
- -Students, this year you may encounter rough patches in some of your classes. Don't be afraid to ask for help. If you need help in our class I am ready and willing to support you. If you need help in another class I am willing to help match you with someone on campus who will support you. Please do not fear not knowing the answer, as learning starts from a position of "not knowing." Our class will encourage a community of academic risk takers, critical thinkers, and creative problem solvers. Students who encounter struggle, and choose to use it as a growth opportunity, learn about their capacity to rise above the goals they initially set for themselves both personally and academically. - -Students should be encouraged to seek help for our class early and often. Office hours will be communicated and open for students to need individual help, study strategies, to complete work in a comfortable setting, and to facilitate group study teams.

Social Emotional Support

- -Keep your student ID with you at all times and refer to the emotional and mental health support information on the back of your ID as soon as you feel you or a peer may need help. The REC is about supporting our community and students at all times. There are many trusted adults on campus who are ready and willing to help you and your friends.
- -Keep a close eye on your stress level. Seek ways to reduce stress and decompress using healthy coping skills away from electronics such as play, music, face to face talk, spending time outdoors, cooking, visiting with friends, coloring, art, physical exercise, breathing, and attention to present moment awareness. Explore new ways to manage your time and growing responsibilities..
